Canada is the world's second largest country after Russia. It covers more than half of North America. The capital city of the country is Ottawa. English and French are official languages in Canada. Sixty per cent of Canada's population lives on the shores of the St Lawrence River and the Great Lakes. This region is home to two of Canada's largest cities, Toronto and Montreal. Toronto is the capital of Ontario and Montreal is the capital of Quebec. Quebec was once a French territory and the majority of Canada's French speakers live there. Quebec and Ontario are the southern provinces of Canada. The lakes and forests of this region are important sources of wood and hydroelectricity.

The Winter Olympic Games were held in Canada twice: in Calgary (1998) and Vancouver (2010) and the Summer Olympic Games took place in Montreal (1976).

In 1867, Canada had a population of 3,4 million. Today it is over 30 million. This is because of immigration from every part of the world. Canada has more than 50 native languages. The original tribes in Canada range from the Inuit to the Mohawks and Cree.

Nunavut – 'our land' in the Inuktitut language – has been home to the Inuit for thousands of years. The population of Nunavut is about 30 thousand and most of the communities are very small. Fuel and food arrive by plane or by ship.

The Canadian National Tower in Toronto is the tallest tower in the world. It is 553 metres high, but it isn't as high as the Dubai Tower. Canada's border with the USA is the longest border in America. It is nearly 9 thousand kilometres long. Canada has so many lakes and rivers that it has 30% of the world's fresh water. Lake Superior, one of the five great lakes, is the largest freshwater lake in the world.

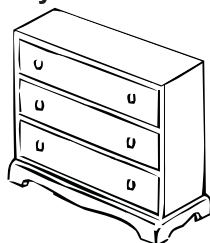
