Valentine's Day is on 14<sup>th</sup> February. In the UK and the USA, it's a day of love! People send romantic cards but they don't sign their names. There are often little poems in the cards. People sometimes give presents too, like flowers or chocolates.

Diwali is a national holiday in India and Nepal. This is a festival of light. Everybody lights little lamps in homes and streets. It marks the beginning of the new year. Indian people eat special spicy food and sweets. They also send their friends and families Diwali cards.

Diwali is celebrated in September or October.

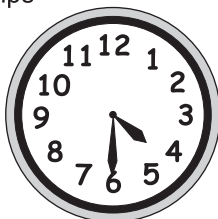
