Gorillas live in small family groups of about fifteen. In a group there is one strong, older male, some young males and a few females with their babies. They move slowly round a large area of jungle eating leaves and fruit.

In some ways gorillas are very like humans. When they are happy, they laugh and wave their arms. When they are angry, they beat their chests. When they are sad, they cry. But they cry quietly, without any tears.

Unfortunately, people hunt and kill gorillas. They also cut down and burn their trees. There are now only about a thousand gorillas left in the world. Gorillas live up to 50 years.

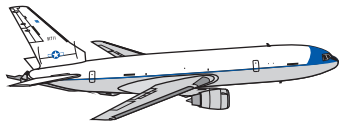

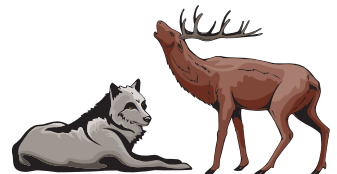
