So they light candles for eight days. They have parties with sweets and cakes and visit their relatives. Children get a lot of presents.

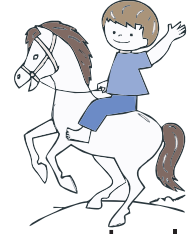
