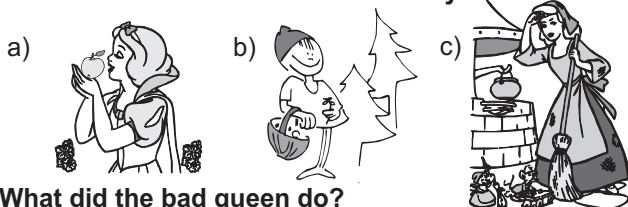


I. READING

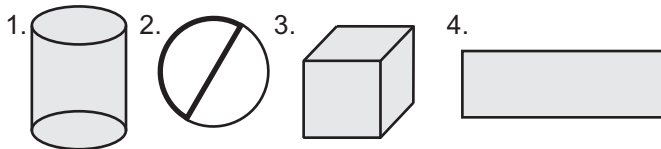

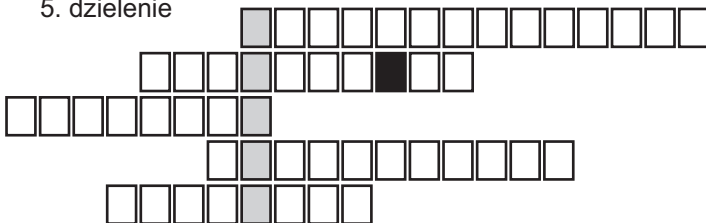
